The most important of these relate to the present and near future, but the great questions involved cannot be fully considered unless the whole range of the phenomena of climate and the principles involved in its changes be taken up in their entirety. As at present treated, the phenomena of climate belong to two branches of science - Geology and Physical Geography. The former takes up the phenomena and causes of the climates including and antedating the Ice age; the latter, through climatology and meteorology, deals with the present distribution of, and variations in, temperature, precipitation, atmosphere, pressure and winds. Under this division of the subject, geological climates are dealt with as being separate and apart from the phenomena with which climatology and meteorology have to deal. These later branches of science, therefore, treat the phenomena and principles of existing climates as relating entirely to the present and near future, and regard...
